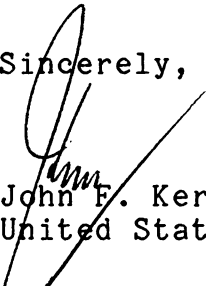
Thank you for your letter and the copies of the resolutions which were adopted by the Cambridge City Council. As always, It was good to hear from you, and to know the actions of the City Council.
