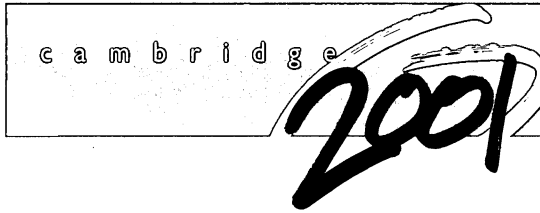

To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$10,278.55 in the Grant Fund of the Fire Department Salary and Wages Account \$8,770.32 and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$1,508.23. The Massachusetts Executive Office of Public Safety has awarded the fire Department funds for the Student Awareness of Fire Education (S.A.F.E.) Program. Firefighters during off-hours will present the comprehensive fire safety program to all elementary schools using the National Fire Protection Agency curriculum. This program continues to set down the building blocks necessary for children to practice sound fire safety in their formative years and on to adulthood. Funds will be used to cover overtime costs and for program materials.
