IN CITY COUNCIL

ORDERED:

That in accordance with the provisions of the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge, Chapter Three, Section 3-2, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to J. Jesse Fox on behalf of the St. Peter's Episcopal Church Activity Committee, _____ for the purpose of conducting a display of merchandise to be held on Saturday, September 29, 1984, with a rain date of October 6, 1984 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. and on all Saturdays during the months of September, October and November, commencing immediately and running through the spring, summer and fall seasons at the premises on the west side of Sellars St. and north side of Green St., for the purpose of displaying and selling merchandise on the sidewalk at said premises, provided that no such permit shall be granted to exceed more than twenty-five percent of the width of the sidewalk from the property line of the premises in front of which said display shall be installed and provided further that before erecting the above named display, the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.), conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said display.
