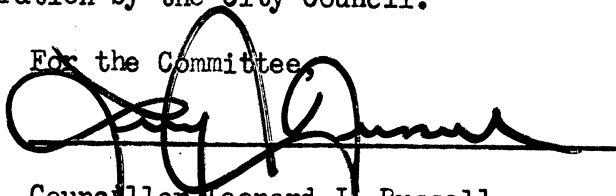
to which was referred a communication from John G. Carberry of the law firm of Csaplar and Bok relative to the conveyance of 2037 square feet of land to Northeastern Realty, Inc. of Cambridge resulting from the realignment and acceptance of Amesbury Street as a public way of the City of Cambridge on July 7, 1976.

The committee met on Thursday, September 16, 1976 at 6:00 P. M. and heard from Attorney John G. Carberry from the law firm of Csaplar and Bok relative to the conveyance of 2037 square feet of land to Northeastern Realty, Inc. of Cambridge. Attorney Carberry stated that the realignment of Amesbury Street by the City Council on July 7, 1976 had created two parcels of land whose ownership could not be traced. Attorney Carberry further stated that if all parties concerned would join in conveying any interest that they might have in the parcels to Northeastern Realty, Inc. the result would be a better traffic pattern on Amesbury Street and better access by Northeastern Realty, Inc. to their loading platform and improvement in traffic conditions in that area.
