- WHEREAS: The Simplex property has lain fallow for a number of years; and
- WHEREAS: Negotiations are underway between the present owner and one of our most significant community institutions, the Polaroid Corporation; and
- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge is quite proud to have this prestigious company call Cambridge "home"; and
- WHEREAS: A Polaroid development on the Simplex site would provide considerable and various benefits to the City of Cambridge such as tax revenue, jobs, solidify Polaroid's future in Cambridge, and uplift the general Central Square area to name a few places; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That this City Council go on record urging a positive negotiation process between the private parties involved and that the City offer any and all of their resources to expedite the realization of this dream; and be it further
- ORDERED: That copies of this resolution be forwarded to the appropriate representative of the Polaroid Corporation and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.
