- WHEREAS: Often times, our play grounds are used by people who dispose of trash carelessly and in so doing cause neighboring streets to become littered; and
- WHEREAS: Our FWD, when sent to clean litter from these public parks, sometimes does not clean the streets and sidewalks surrounding the parks; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That when the FWD cleans parks and playgrounds, that the streets and sidewalks surrounding the parks be cleaned, and that appropriate "No Littering" signs be placed prominently in the vicinity of all parks in the City.
