WHEREAS: Intense complaints have been received from several residents in the area of 488 Franklin Street and Franklin Place regarding an increase in the presence of intoxicated people and persons of unsavory behavioural practices hanging around, loitering and harassing residents of that area; and

WHEREAS: Empty and broken bottles, human waste and additional refuse are being strewn on resident's and tenant's porches and steps; and

WHEREAS: During the weekend of September 12 - 13, 1987 an attempted break-in was made at an apartment in the area by one of the loiterers, a record of which is on file with the Cambridge Police Department; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager direct the Chief of Police to insure that this problem be remedied, that the area be swept and continued surveillance of the Franklin Street/Franklin Place neighborhood be established in order to prevent repetition of the problem; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to the City Council by October 19, 1987, confirming that appropriate response is in process and is working.
