IN CITY COUNCIL

June 23, 1986

- WHEREAS:** This City Council is in receipt of a petition from Theodore R. Live on behalf of the Cambridge Farmers' Market requesting permission to use the City-owned parking lot without charge located on Bishop Allen Drive and Norfolk Street on each Monday from the second Monday in July (July 14, 1986) to the last Monday in October (October 27, 1986), during the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.; now therefore be it
- ORDERED:** That in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Theodore R. Live on behalf of the Cambridge Farmers' Market for the erection of a banner across Massachusetts Avenue at the corner of Norfolk Street from July 14, 1986 to October 27, 1986;
- Provided that before erecting the above named banner the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.) Dollars conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said banner; and be it further
- ORDERED:** That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the departments concerned to grant the required permits and licenses pursuant to the request of the petitioner; and be it further
- ORDERED:** That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Commissioner of Traffic and Parking to waive all parking fees for the meters within the parking lot located on Bishop Richard Allen Drive and Norfolk Street and the surrounding areas for the purpose of allowing consumers to participate in the Farmers' Market during the period when the market is being conducted and to take whatever steps are necessary, including the posting of signs, to ensure that the intent of this order is being carried out.
