The resurfacing of Railroad Crossings in Massachusetts now is the responsibility of the State Highway Department.

The Traffic and Parking Department, along with the Public Works Department, have met on numerous occasions with the State Highway Department to develop a program for the repair and maintenance of all Railroad Crossings and Bridges in the City of Cambridge. They have advised us that the Sherman Street crossing is the next one to be done in the City. We anticipate this work being started this spring.

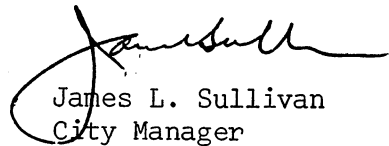
