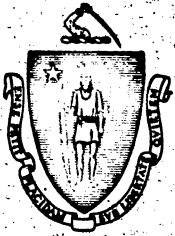
Under the provisions of Chapter 32 Section 59A the City Treasurer shall make this payment of the State Retirement Board.


To the Honorable, the City Council,
