- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that veteran Cambridge Police Officer John P. Riley will soon retire from active duty, completing thirty-two years of service with the Department; and
- WHEREAS: John, a lifelong Cantabrigian, attended local schools, graduating from Rindge Technical High School in 1938 and served his country well during World War II as a member of the United States Coast Guard; and
- WHEREAS: Having been honorably discharged in 1945 John later worked for B and B Chemical Company until being appointed as a reserve Police Officer on September 10, 1953, becoming a permanent Patrol Officer three years later on September 9, 1956, at which time he began a series of general patrol duties, being assigned as both a Route Patrol Officer, as well as a Mobile Unit Officer; and
- WHEREAS: John was the "regular 21X" route man in North Cambridge for many years, protecting the residents and merchants with tireless dedication and with the enthusiasm so characteristic of John, an enthusiasm he carried with him upon being assigned to City Hall in 1980 as "Chief of Security", the position from which he will retire; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest appreciation and gratitude to Officer John P. Riley on the occasion of his retirement from active duty and to further extend every good wish to him and to his wife, Mary for continued good health and happiness in the years ahead; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Officer Riley on behalf of the entire City Council.
