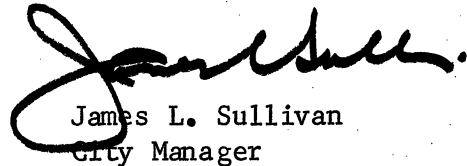

To the Honorable, the City Council:

At the City Council meeting held on February 23, 1970, a petition was received from residents in the vicinity of the Cambridge Highlands requesting that the City take immediate action to create a playground on land located at the rear of Sancta Maria Hospital. This petition was referred to the City Manager for report. I have contacted representatives of the Cambridge Highlands Area to discuss this problem with them. They have requested that I assign the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation, Paul Cowles, to work with the neighborhood to design some recreational facilities on the land owned by the City at this location. I have agreed to this request and Mr. Cowles will contact neighborhood representatives to determine their desires and to estimate the proposed cost for such a development.
