In City Council,

WHEREAS:-

On May 1, 1972, this City Council adopted by the affirmative vote of eight members an order which states in part, "that the City Council go on record favoring the passage of House Bill 329..."

WHEREAS:- The House Bill 329 provides

Notwithstanding any provision of general or special law to the contrary, any company subject to the control of the department of public utilities, shall rebate fifty per cent of any charge made to any person over the age of sixty-five who has resided within the Commonwealth for more than five years, and is the head of a household.

WHEREAS:- The order adopted on May 1, 1972 contained the language of the Little Brooke Amendment as opposed to the contents of the aforesaid bill

ORDERED:- That this City Council go on record favoring passage of House Bill 329 and act granting a rebate to certain persons over the age of sixty-five as provided in House Bill 329.
