

Rules

to be observed by the employees of the Street Department.

1st The hours of labor shall be from 6.30 O'clock A.M. to 11.30 A.M. and from 1 P.M. to 5.30 P.M. on Saturday to 5 P.M.

2nd Men who know where their work is shall be on the ground ready to commence work at the time named! - those who do not know must be in the yard at the stable ready to go where directed.

3rd Teamsters and those in charge of horses must have them fed, watered, cleaned and harnessed, so as to be ready to hitch them up at the hour named. The teamsters shall remain at their work until the time named for leaving off. "unless there is a given number of loads to a days work, or the work in hand is finished." In no case shall working horses be driven faster than a walk, unless to avoid an accident.

4th The men and teams employed in collecting ashes shall finish each days route before leaving off at night.

In case of obstructions in the street from any cause, the men called upon to remove them shall forthwith obey the order therefor! -

In case of a fall of snow rendering it necessary or probably necessary to remove the same for the convenience of Sunday travel, each teamster and laborer in the department shall report at the stable yard ready at 7.30 a.m. for orders.

13th Any violation of the above rules shall be deemed sufficient cause for the dismissal of the violator.
