

City of Cambridge,
in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine.

An Ordinance,
relating to the collection of Taxes.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City
of Cambridge, as follows:—

1. The City Treasurer may be the collector
of Taxes, and of all rents and other sums paya-
-ble to the City, not otherwise specially provided
for; and, as Treasurer and collector, he shall re-
-ceive a salary of six hundred dollars per an-
-num, payable quarterly; which shall be in full
for his services; and all fees for summonses,
warrants, and other services, received by him,
shall be paid into the City Treasury.

2. All persons, who shall pay their taxes on
or before the tenth day of October, shall be entitled
to a discount of four per cent; after which time,
no discount shall be allowed; and on the first
day of November, the collector is directed to issue
his summons to those who are then delinquent,
that if their taxes are not paid within ten days
from the date of said summons, with twenty cents
for said summons, the collector will then pro-
-ceed to collect the same according to law; and
the collector shall give notice, by attaching to
all tax bills the above section of this Ordinance.

3. The collector shall be provided by the City
Council with an office, in some suitable and

convenient place, which office shall be kept open, for the reception of taxes and transaction of other business, every Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday, from nine o'clock A.M. to one o'clock P.M., excepting from the fifteenth day of September to the fifteenth day of October, during which time his office shall be kept open every day, (Sundays excepted,) from nine o'clock A.M. to one o'clock P.M.

4. All other ordinances and parts of Ordinances, inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
