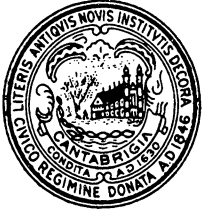

To the Honorable, the City Council:

City Council approval is requested for the acceptance of money to be given to the City from time to time by persons who have agreed to pay for a tree to be planted in their area of the City which does not come under the Block Grant program. At the present time the City has received approximately \$5,240 for this purpose.

This money is to be deposited in a special trust and agency account for use each year in April to purchase trees for planting, with the Public Works Department doing the planting. As with other trust and agency accounts, the City Treasurer will be the sole custodian of funds and payments to vendors will be made on the City's vendor system, with the transfer of funds from this amount to cover payments to vendors.

Passage of the enclosed order is recommended.
