WHEREAS: The tragic fire and explosion we had recently in Kendall Square would have undoubtedly been much worse if it were not for the superb performance of our Fire Department, and

WHEREAS: Yet one problem that seemed evident was that the heat generated made it difficult for the firemen to operate the pumper, therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to confer with the Fire Chief to determine if a protective shield or some other method of reducing this hazard might be in order, and be it further

ORDERED: That a report be filed in two weeks so that the Council can continue to be supportive of our outstanding Fire Department if any recommendations which might be made may be addressed by the Council.
