- WHEREAS: Sojourner, having just gone through a difficult time of reorganization and expansion, has now raised \$40,000 to resume publication in March with the addition of broader-based community news and coverage of issues of concern to women; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council wishes the Sojourner much success in its expanded endeavor in the celebration of its tenth year; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That an engrossed copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Sojourner.
