Mich. sisters safe; kidnap suspects held

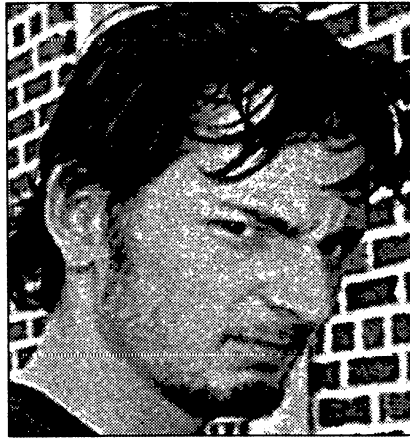

KALAMAZOO, Mich. – Two young sisters missing since they stepped off a school bus last Friday were found unhurt yesterday morning in Daytona Beach, Fla., as their three abductors were arrested after being identified by a Harvard student.

Teresa Hainer, 9, and Jessica Hainer, 6, of Galesburg, Mich., were the subject of a four-day nationwide search.

"The girls are safe," FBI Special Agent Joseph Martinolich said at a news conference in Kalamazoo. "We were told by the agents at the scene that they're none the worse for the wear. Maybe a little tired, a little bedraggled, maybe disheveled, but they're in good shape."

The girls were bathed, given medical examinations and brought to

arrived by private plane. "You didn't get a tan. What happened?" grandmother Olivia Hainer said as she hugged the girls at the airport.]

Police in Daytona Beach arrested

the three suspects – acquaintances of the girls' father – about 9:30 a.m. as they and the girls entered a gift shop on the Daytona beachfront.

A college missionary from Cambridge, Mass., spoke to the suspects and the girls at length Monday and called police after she recognized their pictures on television.

"I met them out on the beach. They looked kind of scruffy," said Loh-Sze Leung, 20, a Harvard University student who was in Daytona with an evangelical group.

"The girls seemed kind of, unhappy or shy. But nothing seemed wrong," she said.

Ronald Stafford, 21, his brother Lee Stafford, 17, and Ricky Geer, 19, were arrested on federal kidnapping charges. They also will be charged with kidnapping under Michigan state law, which will allow Lee Stafford to be tried as an adult.

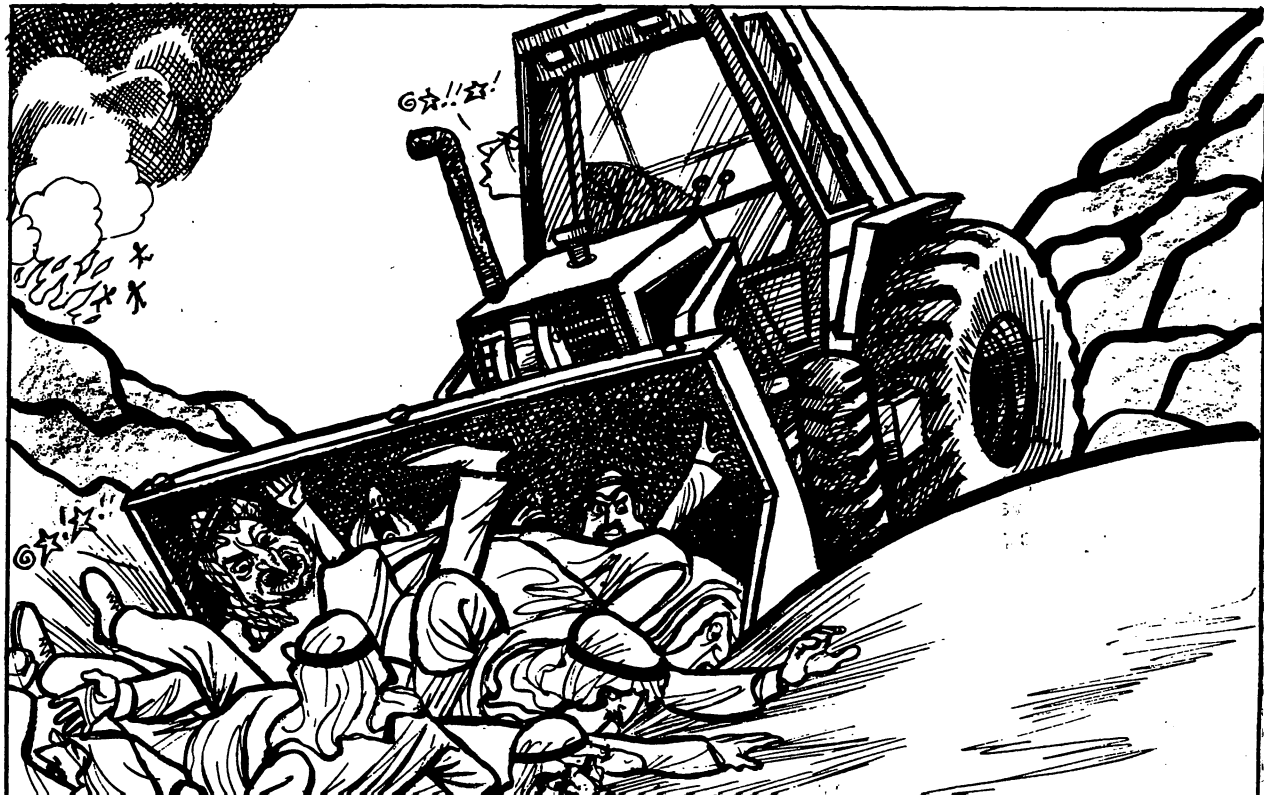
