- WHEREAS: The golf cart was tipped almost sideways and had three golfers riding inside; and
- WHEREAS: Frank Reilly was yelling for Jim Bergin, a member of the Cambridge Fire Department and formerly of the Rescue team, to help someone in the cart; and
- WHEREAS: Bill Flynn was apparently suffering from heart failure, his complexion was bluish, he was not breathing at all, so Jim Bergin and Frank Reilly lifted Bill Flynn off the cart and put him flat on the ground; and
- WHEREAS: Jim let it known they needed help fast and Jim Bergin started CPR while Frank Reilly began pumping Bill's chest. At that point Ed Carney saw a house nearby and ran to the backyard and yelled for someone to call an ambulance. By the time he returned Bill Flynn was breathing to a point and seemed to get better as time went on; and
- WHEREAS: The rescue team arrived and took Bill Flynn to a nearby hospital. The hospital called later at the country club to inform them Bill Flynn was doing fine. Following a brief stay in the hospital Bill Flynn was sent home; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council thank Jim Bergin, Bill McCarthy, Terry Walsh and Ed Carney for their quick action and involvement in saving Bill Flynn's life; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Jim Bergin, Bill McCarthy, Frank Reilly and Ed Carney on behalf of the entire City Council.
