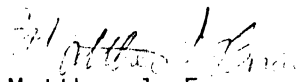
Dear Sir:

Notice is hereby given to the City of Cambridge in accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Annotated Chapter 84, Section 18, as amended, advising the City of Cambridge that at approximately 7:30 p.m. on September 19, 1978, Mrs. Rose Ferraro was caused to fall by a defect in the public way in the City of Cambridge, to wit: broken and crumbling asphalt near the intersection of Cambridge and Fourth Streets on the Cambridge Street highway three-quarters of the way from the northerly side to the southerly side and to the corner going in a westerly direction.
