The *Joint* Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges
to which *was* referred the petition of J. W. Estabrook,
and others praying for the acceptance of Frost Street,
so-called, from Harris Street, Southely.

Reports

~~Recommending~~ That Your com-
mittee has already reported upon a similar petition for the
acceptance of the private way before mentioned. The place
has been visited by the committee twice within a few weeks,
and there does not appear to be any reason for changing
the decision heretofore made in the matter. There has been no
plan filed, and the place has not been finished as a street.

Besides the objection that the street is not finished as such,
there is another, that it has not of late years, been the
policy of ^{the} Committee on Roads and Bridges to recommend for
acceptance, courts and places that extend only to a dead end.

Your committee must therefore recommend that the petitioners
have leave to withdraw.
