That the Committee on Public Property be and is hereby authorized, whenever the owner of the Hotel Estate at in Ward 3, hereofore known as the Craigie House, or Lechmere House, shall have executed such instrument in writing as shall be deemed satisfactory, to enclose the square in front of said Hotel, at the junction of Cambridge and Bridge Streets, with a suitable fence, and to construct and grade a sidewalk ^{upon 3^d Street,} around the same & the expense thereof to be charged to the Appropriation for Public Squares.
