AMERICAN TELECOMMUNICATIONS CORPORATION

American Telecommunications Corporation ("American" or "Company") seeks permission from the Department of Public Utilities to provide interexchange telephone service within Massachusetts. American's services would be offered primarily to hotels, motels, hospitals, temporary housing units and similar traffic aggregators. The Company has also filed a tariff of rates and charges for the above-described service. The tariff investigation has been docketed as D.P.U. 90-16.

The above investigation is officially captioned:

Application of American Telecommunications Corporation under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws, as amended, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a resale, value-added or interexchange common carrier within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

American Telecommunications Corporation ("American" or "Company") proposes to offer direct dialed services to traffic aggregators such as hotels, motels, hospitals, etc. for resale within Massachusetts. The Company has also filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity which has been docketed as D.P.U. 89-258.

The above investigation is officially captioned:

Investigation by the Department on its own motion as to the propriety of the rates and charges set forth in the following tariff: M.D.P.U. No. 1, Original pages 1 through 24, filed with the Department on January 3, 1990 to become effective February 2, 1990 by American Telecommunications Corp.

The Department of Public Utilities will conduct a public hearing on the above matter at its hearing room, #1210 Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts on Wednesday, March 14, 1990 at 10:00 a.m.

The petitioner, American Telecommunications Corporation, is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once at least twenty-one days prior to said date in the Boston Globe, The Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and The Evening

Gazette (Worcester), and to serve a copy hereof at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date on the attached list, and to make return of service and publication at the time of the hearing.
