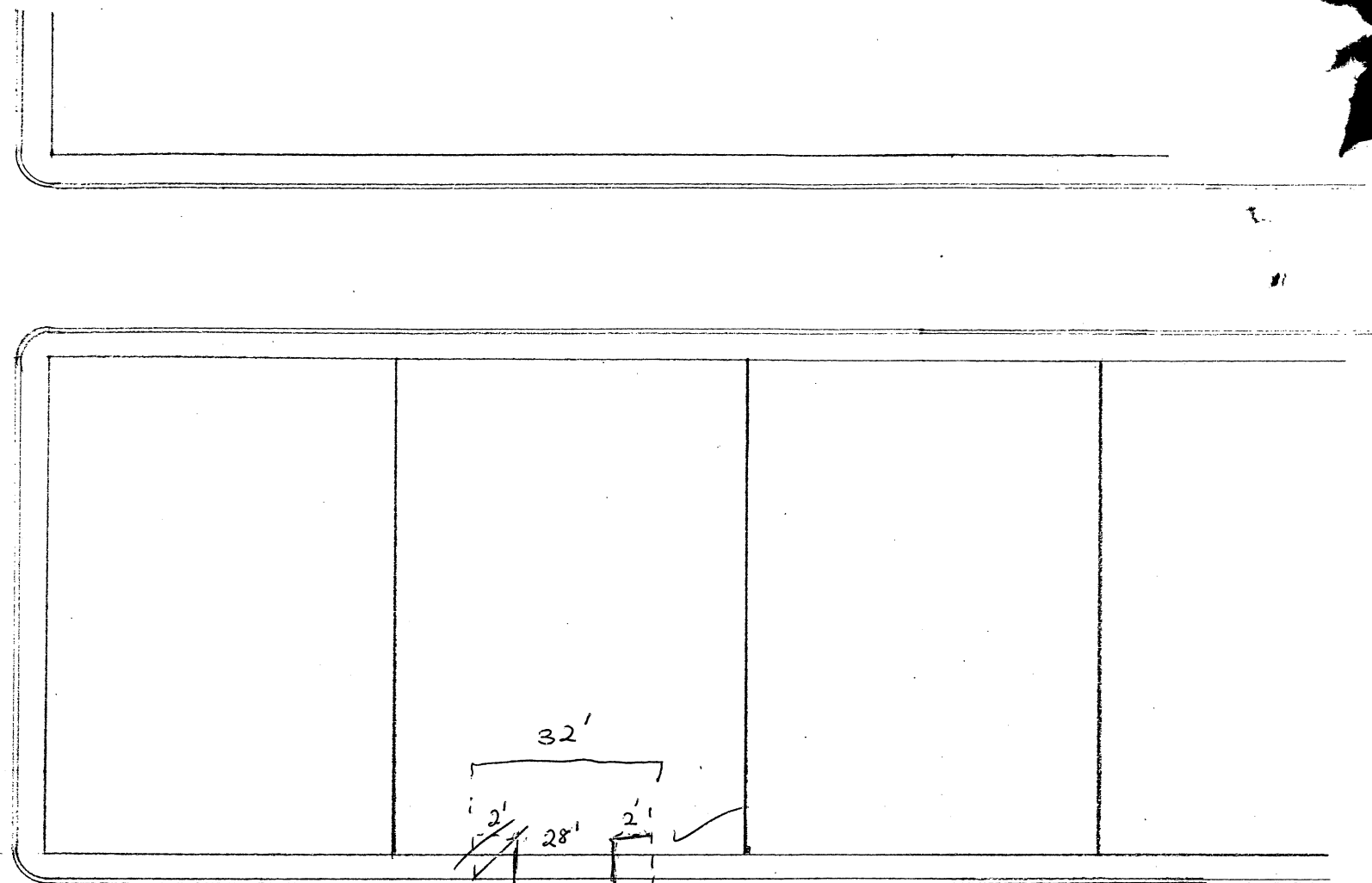

We at Bread + Circus would like to widen our driveway located at 115 Prospect Street. The driveway is especially crowded when cars are entering and exiting the driveway at the same time. Often cars are forced over the curb which is of course very hard on their tires. Subsequently we have received complaints. The current width of the driveway is 28'. We would like to widen the driveway by at least 2' on either side or a total of at least 4'. We also would like to round the corner of the curb off + not have a sudden drop between the curb and the driveway.

There is no parking on our side of Prospect St. for cars so we would not be cutting down on available parking spaces. The wider driveway should provide a much safer situation for cars and consumers who frequent our store.
