WHEREAS: The Walking Club of the Council on Aging has met with the Friends, and has begun a drive entitled "Supporting Cambridge Seniors Makes Cents"; and

WHEREAS: This drive involves collecting pennies, the goal being to collect one million pennies, (\$10,000) for additional items for the Center; and

WHEREAS: They have enlisted the support of the Fire Department, which has designated the neighborhood fire stations as drop off sites for penny collections, the Cambridge Council of Boy Scouts who have volunteered to collect, neighborhood businesses which will put receptacles on their premises, and many city departments; and

WHEREAS: In order to be successful, this dedicated group needs the support of all Cantabrigians, young and old; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record as being supportive of the Seniors in their efforts, and to encourage all citizens to either drop off the pennies they have in their closets, bureau drawers, piggy banks, etc., at the nearest Fire Station, or call the City Council office for a pickup if they cannot get out and further be it resolved, that the city council go on record as wishing the seniors "good luck" and keep those pennies rolling in!
