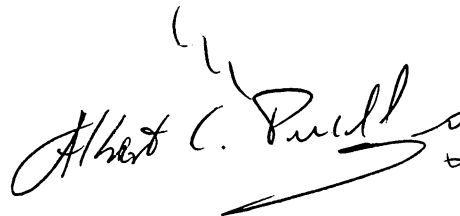

The Honorable Cambridge City Councillors:

Given reports and the facts of the constant and yearly highly increase of rents lately by the Cambridge Rent Control Board, therefore Cambridge Tenants for Stronger Rent Control, ask the Cambridge City Council and or through the Cambridge City Clerk or the Cambridge Rent Control Board, to request all cities across the nation on rent control, tape or print copies of their computerized lists of charged rents and rent increases each time since their year-establishment of rent control.

Then, a xerox or printed copy from a computer tape copy from each city on rent control, including Cambridge, will be place on every Library branch in Cambridge for public enquire, investigation, comparing and research, and so in case of positive evidence thereafter bring public pressure at hearings or by mail to get the Cambridge Rent Control to lower the rents, as is being suspect of booting out many Rent Controlled tenants out of Cambridge given the increasingly higher and speculating like rents under the supposed rent control in Cambridge as voted early by the people to stop real estate corruption in Cambridge through higher rents and wholesale eviction of workers and low & middle income people and tenants of the City of Cambridge.
