In the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-six,

An Ordinance,
directing the manner in which the Ordinances of the
City Council and the Orders of the Mayor and Al-
dermen shall be promulgated.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge, as follows:—

All the Ordinances of
the City Council and all the Orders of the Mayor
and Aldermen shall be published and promulga-
ted, by causing the same to be inserted, four weeks
successively, in such newspaper as shall be print-
ed and published in the City; or, in case no news-
paper shall be printed and published in the City,
then in such newspaper or newspapers, printed and
published in the City of Boston, as the Mayor and
Aldermen shall from time to time designate.
