Gentlemen.

In compliance with directions contained in an order passed May 10th relating to "a plan of North Avenue from the Fitchburg Railroad Bridge Southerly to Church St.", I herewith present a plan, which shows minutely said Avenue as it is now fenced and occupied between the points named as deduced from surveys taken; and have also drawn upon the same lines, which I recommend for "defining the lines of said Avenue," substantially in accordance with the views of the Joint Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges as set forth in their report made May 3^d 1871.
