
COUNCILLOR CRANE

- WHEREAS: The service supplied to the users of the North Cambridge trolley line has deteriorated considerably because of the new stop at the Cambridge Common; and
- WHEREAS: The connection with the train for such users is inconvenient and will be worsened during the winter; and
- WHEREAS: This decrease in service should be reflected in a decrease in the M.B.T.A. assessment; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to contact all appropriate authorities both on the city and state level as to the possibility of accounting for this decrease in service in the M.B.T.A. assessment; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to file a written report as to the action taken by him pursuant to this order within one week.
