I also look forward to discussing with you and others the arrangements for the Civic Unity Committee meeting that will be held at M.I.T. on February 28.

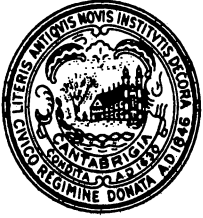


