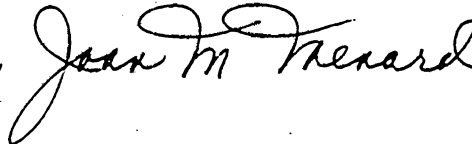
AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN POSITIONS IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF
CAMBRIDGE FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court
assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

The positions of superintendent and deputy superintendent of police in the
city of Cambridge shall be exempt from the provisions of chapter thirty-one of
the General Laws. Persons holding such positions shall be deemed to be mana-
gerial employees for purposes of chapter one hundred and fifty E of the Gener-
al Laws.

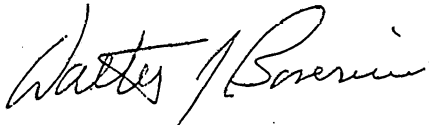
