That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to the City Council within two weeks concerning complaints received about the replacement of water lines on Rice Street. These complaints concern long delays in installation, repeated digging up of the street in the same area, and lack of close supervision of this work by the city.

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Traffic and Parking Department to conduct a thorough analysis of cars parked in the yard at 19 Hilliard Street to ascertain whether the parking lot is being used for the residents of this residential house in a residential area or whether the parking yard is being used as a commercial parking lot and to report back to the City Council within two weeks.

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the City Treasurer and the City's Retirement Board to conduct an analysis of all city invested and pension funds to determine the feasibility and advisability of divesting these portfolios of all investments in any way related to the tobacco industry and to report these findings to the City Council within six weeks.
