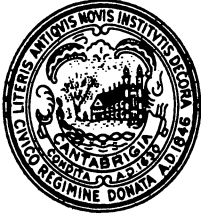



I am pleased to inform the City Council that on December 24, 1976, the City was officially notified by the Bureau of Outdoor Recreation of a grant award of \$90,000 under the terms and procedures of the Land and Water Conservation Act of 1965. These funds will be matched with \$90,000 in City funds (approved by the City Council in the 1975-76 Public Investment Fund Budget) and used to complete the Cambridge Common renovation project.
