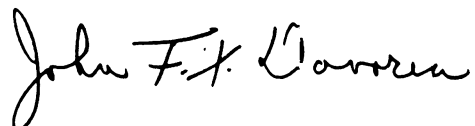

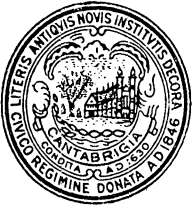

The corporation will serve as a forum for the exchange of ideas between communities, health groups, women's rights groups, hospitals, schools, neighborhood organizations, etc. The corporation is to be an experiment in consensual, non-profit filmmaking, and will train apprentices in the skills of motion picture production.

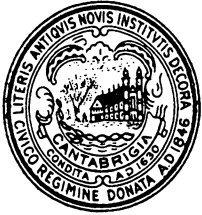

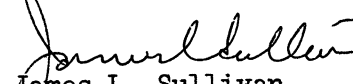
