- WHEREAS: At present Ms. Colon is living in the YWCA, 32 City Square in Boston, with her family. They were sent to the YMCA by the Cambridge Welfare Department. The attached letter explains that the Colon family may remain at the "Y" for a limited period of time; and
- WHEREAS: Ms. Colon has five children, Hector, Pedro, Betzaida, Joan and Adaida, three of the children are in the Longfellow School bilingual program and two are in CRLS; and
- WHEREAS: This family came from Puerto Rico, an American Commonwealth, was a former resident of Cambridge and is presently homeless; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record requesting that the Cambridge Housing Authority consider the case of Rosalina Colon, as of an emergency nature and provide her with an apartment to house her family of 6; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge Housing Authority be and hereby is requested to pursue every effective means of providing housing for this family, including the Section 8 program and consultation with the Massachusetts MHFA.
