The operation of beano games have provided great relaxation to the citizens of this city particularly the elderly who presently are forced to take bus rides to places outside the Commonwealth, therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That the City Clerk be and hereby is directed to use every means possible to inform the voters of the City of Cambridge that this question will appear on the November ballot as one of several referendum questions at the next City Election and cannot appear again on the ballot until the year 1975.
