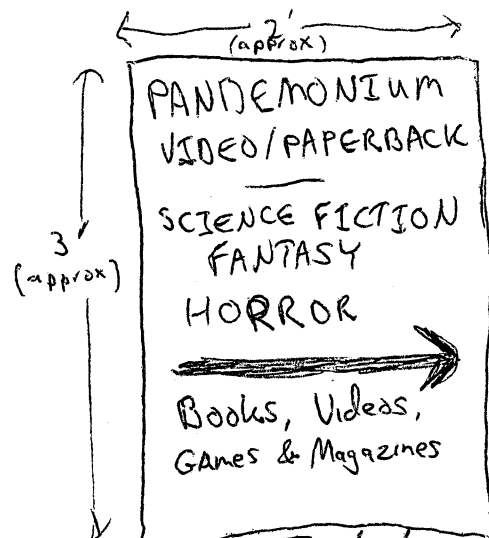
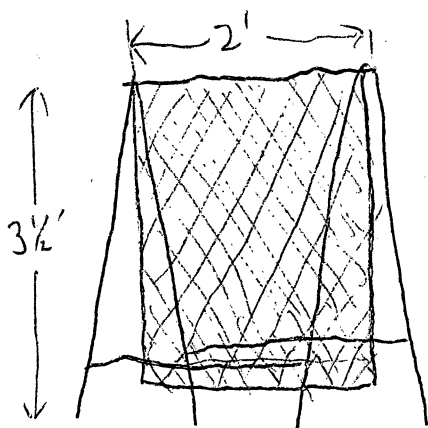
The undersigned respectfully pray
