- WHEREAS:** It has come to the attention of this City Council that Firefighter Daniel V. Cremins has retired from active duty on the Cambridge Fire Department, and
- WHEREAS:** Firefighter Cremins was first appointed to the department on January 15, 1939 at which time he was assigned to Rescue Company 1 where he remained until he was transferred to Engine Company 6 on May 16, 1943, where he remained until March 30, 1947 when he was transferred to Engine Company 5, and
- WHEREAS:** Having briefly served at Engine Company 5 he was transferred to Engine Company 3 where he remained until March 8, 1953 at which time he was transferred to Engine Company 4, and
- WHEREAS:** Firefighter Cremins remained at this assignment until June 21, 1956 at which time he became an Aide to the Deputy Chief and served in that capacity until 1960 when he returned to Engine Company 4, and
- WHEREAS:** He remained at Engine Company 4 until January 9, 1966 when he became Aide to the Chief, a position he held with distinction until his retirement on May 1, 1977, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That this City Council go on record extending our sincere gratitude to Firefighter Daniel V. Cremins for his dedication to duty for a total of 38 years and to further extend to him our best wishes for a healthy and happy retirement, and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare for presentation a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution on behalf of the entire City Council.
