- WHEREAS: This form of travel is likely to become popular as more and more earthbound traffic jams make commuting impossible; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to have the City Solicitor prepare a comprehensive legal opinion on the City Council authority in Helicopter, including, but not limited to, the Council's authority, through zoning or licensing, to regulate heliports, to enforce the noise ordinance, or to affect the routes of helicopters.
