ORDERED: That the City Manager direct the Public Works Commissioner to arrange, as soon as possible, for installaion of an adequate number of prominently positioned signs throughout the Central Square area which will indicate that public restrooms are available at City Hall, the Police Station, and the Fire Station at Lafayette Square, Massachusetts Avenue and Sidney Street; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to the City Council within one week to indicate the quickest possible time frame within which this projection of signage will be completed as a critical element in an intensified effort to upgrade the sanitary condition and appearance of Central Square.
