NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the inhabitants of the City of Cambridge qualified as the law directs, are hereby notified and warned to assemble at the voting places designated by the Election Commission in their respective wards and precincts on Tuesday, the sixteenth day of September, 1980 then and there to give in their votes for the purpose of nominating candidates for Congressman for the Eighth Congressional District including all wards of the City of Cambridge; in all Precincts of Wards 8, 9, 10 and 11 for a Councillor for the Third Councillor District; in all Precincts of Wards 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 for a Councillor for the Sixth Councillor District; in all Precincts of Wards 8, 9, 10 and 11 for a Senator in the Middlesex and Suffolk District; in all Precincts of Wards 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 for a Senator in the Suffolk and Middlesex District; in Precincts 3 of Ward 6 and in all Precincts of Wards 8, 9, 10 and 11 for one Representative in the General Court for the Twenty-Seventh Middlesex District; in Precincts 3, 4, and 5 of Ward 3, and all Precincts of Ward 4, and Precincts 3, 4, and 5 of Ward 5, and Precincts 2, 4, and 5 of Ward 6 and all Precincts of Ward 7 for one Representative in the General Court for the Twenty-Eighth Middlesex District; in all Precincts of Wards 1 and 2, and in Precincts 1 and 2 of Ward 3, and Precincts 1 and 2 of Ward 5, and Precincts 1 of Ward 6 for one Representative in the General Court for the Twenty-Ninth Middlesex District; for two County Commissioners for Middlesex County; for a Sheriff for Middlesex County; and such vacancies as may occur; all of the official ballots as prepared by the Secretary of State.
