

City of Cambridge

In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred
and Sixty four.

An Ordinance
in relation to the office and duties of
Superintendent of Streets and Drains.

Be it ordained, by the City Council
of the City of Cambridge as follows: -

Sec. 1. The offices of Superintendent of
Streets and Superintendent of Drains
are hereby united.

Sec. 2. The present incumbent of those
offices shall be styled the Superintendent
of Streets and Drains, shall hold office
for the current municipal year unless
sooner removed; shall perform all the duties,
and exercise all the powers, incumbent upon,
and vested in the Superintendent of Streets
and Superintendent of Drains by the
Ordinances of the City now in force, and
shall receive the Salaries of those offices
until otherwise ordered. And annually
thereafter, there shall be chosen, at the

Commencement of each municipal year, by a concurrent vote of the City Council, to be first acted upon by the Mayor and Aldermen, an able and discreet person to be styled the Superintendent of Streets and Drains who shall hold his office at the pleasure of the City Council and shall receive such compensation as said Council shall determine. Whenever said office shall become vacant by death resignation or otherwise, a successor shall be appointed in the manner herein prescribed.

Sect. 3. The Superintendent of Streets and Drains shall perform all the duties and exercise all the powers incumbent upon and vested in the Superintendent of Streets and Superintendent of Drains by the ordinances of the City now in force.

Sect 4. All ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
