

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, June 13. 1864.

Whereas a Private Way in Ward One, called Appleton Street, has heretofore been dedicated to the public use by the owners of adjoining lands and is now in a fit condition to become a public highway, - and

Whereas it is adjudged by the Mayor and Aldermen that the public necessity and convenience require that said Street be laid out as a public highway, and that no person will be damaged thereby, or be entitled to any compensation from the City, -

Ordered, That said private way be and hereby is laid out and established as a public highway, by the name of Appleton Street, agreeably to a Plan thereby drawn by W. A. Mason, bearing date Aug. 7th 1863, a copy of which Plan is now before this Board, - to wit, from Brattle Street to Vassall Lane, the same to be forty-five feet in width, as delineated in said Plan.
