IN CITY COUNCIL

September 9, 1974

ORDERED:

That the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Harry N. Katis to place a ten foot dumpster on the sidewalk at the premises numbered 179 Fifth Street for a period of thirty (30) days commencing September 16, 1974 to remove the debris resulting from a fire and the renovation of said premises.

Said permit is granted subject to the following conditions:

1. The contractor to restore existing sidewalk to the condition it was prior to the construction or to a better condition.
2. That no existing travel lanes or parking spaces shall be closed until authorized by the Director of Traffic and Parking.
3. That the conditions having specified shall be subject to the approval of the Director of Traffic and Parking of the City of Cambridge, who may as he deems necessary, require traffic controls or the use of policemen to facilitate the flow of traffic.

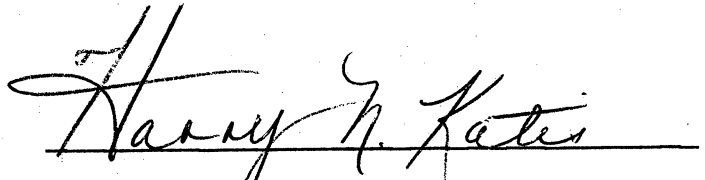
