Boston, June 6, 1956

Petition of Boston Edison Company for determination by the Department of Public Utilities that a certain parcel of land and the substation to be erected thereon and underground lines for transmitting of electricity to be installed therein located at the corner of the Northern Circumferential Highway and Winter Street in Waltham bounded and described as follows:

Easterly by the Circumferential Highway two hundred eighty-one and 11/100 (281.11) feet;
Southerly by Winter Street by two lines measuring fifty-nine and 33/100 (59.33) feet and seventy-nine and 92/100 (79.92) feet, respectively;
Westerly by land now or formerly of Andrew C. Brown along a stone wall three hundred fifteen and 98/100 (315.98) feet; and
Northerly by land of the City of Cambridge along a stone wall by four lines measuring forty-one and 24/100 (41.24) feet, fifteen and 88/100 (15.88) feet, seventeen and 34/100 (17.34) feet and thirty-nine and 73/100 (39.73) feet respectively.

Being the land shown on a "Plan of Land in WALTHAM MASS." by the office of William S. Crocker, Civil Engineer, dated May 23, 1956, and containing according to said plan thirty-six thousand five hundred sixty (36,560) square feet. A copy of said plan is filed herewith.

is reasonably necessary for the convenience and welfare of the public and that said land, substation and structures to be erected thereon be exempted thereon from the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Waltham.

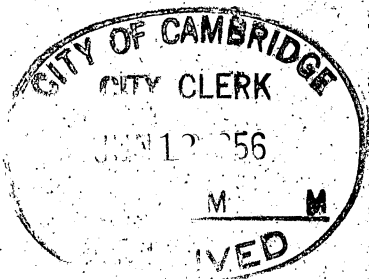
Upon the foregoing petition the Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing at its hearing room, 166 State House, Boston, on Friday the 29th day of June, 1956 at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon.

And the petitioner is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once at least 14 days prior to said date in the Waltham News-Tribune and to serve a copy hereof by registered mail at least 14 days prior to said date on the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Waltham and all persons owning or having an interest in any abutting property, and to make return of service and publication at the time of hearing.

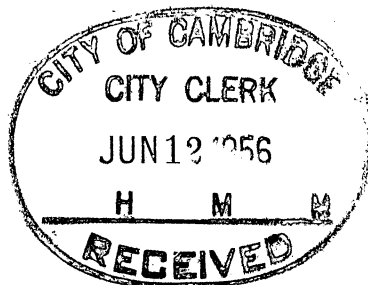


