Dear Councilor;

We are deeply disturbed by the City Council's vote of Nov. 25 to decontrol rents on apartments as they become vacant. We consider this order tantamount to a 'slow death' for Rent Control. In light of the recent attempt by the Rent Board to issue an across the board increase on controlled rents, we consider this move to be part of a pattern that threatens the stability of our neighborhood and other low and moderate income neighborhoods in the city. As a group of tenants and homeowners actively concerned with stabilizing our neighborhood, we are appalled by such a pattern. Likewise, we are angered by a City Council that wittingly participates in it.

Why did the City Council take it upon itself to pass this order? Did it take into consideration the thousands of voters in this city who have consistently opposed any weakening of the current system of controls. We believe it was an underhanded and manipulative ploy on the part of the Council to pass this vote without informing the people of Cambridge beforehand that such a vote was to be taken. We believe the order is illegal and are willing to challenge the Council on it.

Enclosed is a petition supporting the present Rent Control structure. The signatures were collected last winter when Councillor Danehey hurriedly introduced an order to kill Rent Control. In an effort to prevent passage of that order, many of us went to work soliciting support for the existing controls. These 550 names were collected in just 3 days. We present them to you now as evidence that the people of Cambridgeport will not stand for an abolition of Rent Control, whether it be quick and decisive, or slow and ambiguous as the present order is.

Plainly, we are disgusted that it has taken just 9 months for the Council to reverse itself on the order of last winter, and that it was done in such a secretive and cowardly manner. We are especially appalled by Councillor Vellucci's fence sitting. Why has he turned against the people of Cambridge, especially now, when economic conditions make the need for strong controls greater than ever?

We believe that strong Rent Control legislation is vital to maintaining stability on the neighborhood level. Even now, with the existing controls, many of us are being forced to move because rents are too high. We urge you not to weaken the current controls in any way. We will not accept a body that plots in the dark. If our neighborhood is to survive, Rent Control must be, if anything, strengthened to insure the place of working people and their families.
