WHEREAS: That in accordance with Chapter 53, Section 18A of the Massachusetts General Laws which provides that on the petition of ten registered voters a non-binding public opinion advisory question can be placed on the November 6, 1979 ballot for the city election, therefore be it

ORDERED: That the following question shall be placed on the official ballot for November 6, 1979.

"Shall the City Council seek authority from the General Court to enable the city to use zoning to regulate tax-exempt institutions in their uses of land in residentially zoned portions of the City of Cambridge?"
