MASSACHUSETTS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES. BOSTON, March 8, 1974 D.P.U. 17954. Petition of New England Telephone and Telegraph Company for determination by the Department of Public Utilities that public convenience and necessity require locations in portions of a public way under the care and control of the Metropolitan District Commission in the City of Cambridge; namely, Mount Auburn Street, from a point at the northeasterly side of Mount Auburn Street, thence proceeding easterly approximately one hundred and fifty feet (150') of underground conduit to a point at Coolidge Avenue, thence southerly eighty feet (80') of underground conduit to the line of Coolidge Avenue and Mount Auburn Street on the southwesterly corner, to be used for the transmission of intelligence by electricity and to be owned by the Petitioner, all as more particularly shown on plans on file with the petition in the Department.

Upon the foregoing petition, the Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing at its hearing room #1210 Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston 02202, on Friday the 5th day of April 1974 at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon.

And the petitioner is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once at least 14 days prior to said date in the Boston Herald American and the Cambridge Chronicle, to serve a copy hereof by registered mail at least 14 days prior to said date on the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Cambridge and on the Commissioner of the Metropolitan District Commission, and to make return of service and publication at the time of hearing.

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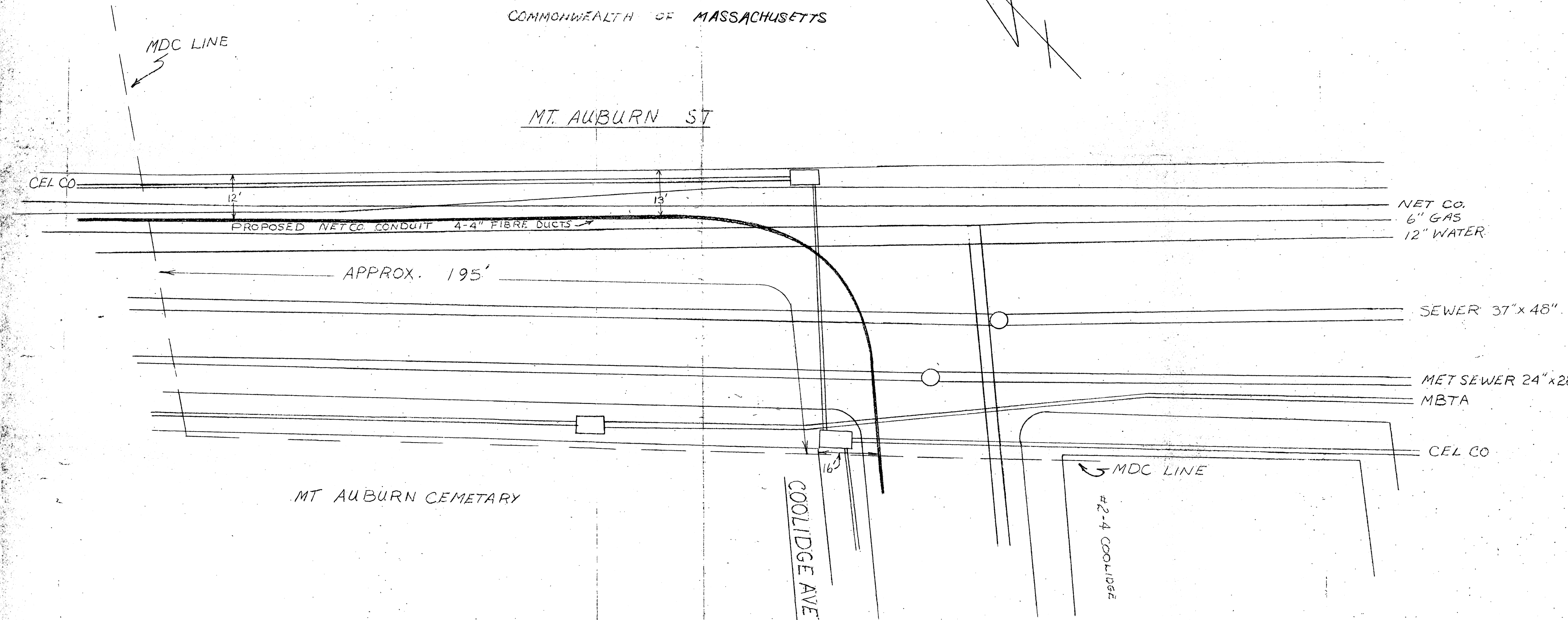
