Be it ordained by the City Council of
the City of Cambridge as follows

The City of Cambridge hereby determines
to assume the ownership, control and
charge of the bridges named in the
first section of an act of the Legislature
of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
entitled "an act ~~to~~ authorizing the Mumuk
Free Bridge Corporation to surrender the
West Boston and Canal Bridges to the
City of Cambridge", approved by the
Governor on the thirtieth day of May in
the year one thousand eight hundred
and fifty seven, as defined in the
ninth section of said act, and upon

the terms and conditions set forth
in said act, and the Mayor is
herby authorised in the name and
in ~~the~~ behalf of the City of Cambridge
to execute ^{in the execution of said act,} that bond ~~performed thereby~~
and to affix the corporate seal of
the city thereto, whenever the said
Hancock Free Bridge Corporation
shall give notice that ~~they are~~ ^{it is}
ready to pay over to the City
of Cambridge the sum of one
hundred thousand dollars agreeably
to the provisions of the fourth section
of said act.
